

Beginning Skating

Snowplow Sam 1, 2, 3 & 4: Ages 3-5 These classes use games and songs to introduce preliminary moves to young skaters. Snow pants, gloves and helmet are recommended.

Basic 1: Ages 6-15 Beginning skaters learn basic skating skills of glides, swizzles and stops.

Beginner Adult/Teen: Students will learn beginning stroking, stopping & crossovers.

Figure Skating

Basic 2: 1 foot glides, back swizzles, 2 foot turns.

Basic 3 (part 1 & 2): Stroking, forward slalom, 2 foot spins.

Basic 4 (part 1 & 2): Forward edges and crossovers, forward outside 3 turns, back stroking.

Basic 5: Backward edges and crossovers, beginning one-foot spins, hockey stop, side toe hop.

Basic 6: Forward inside 3 turns, T-stop, bunny hop, spirals, lunge.

PreFreestyle: Mohawk, ballet jump, backward to forward turn, pivots. Moving forward 3 turns, footwork, one-foot spin, waltz jump, Mazurka.

Freestyle 1-6: All ages After Basic 8, skaters learn advanced jumps, spins, footwork, and other exciting athletic and artistic moves.

Specialty: For all Freestyle level skaters. Work on edges

Hockey Skating

Students will focus on speed, hockey stops, quick turns, footwork, and balance all while skating on hockey skates (no pucks).

Intro to Youth Hockey Skating: An introduction to the core concepts and skating styles taught in Learn to Play Hockey. It is recommended that students have already completed Basic 1 of Learn to Skate.

Advanced Youth Hockey Skating: Current youth hockey players can use this class to excel their footwork on the ice.

MAKE-UP CLASSES

Students may make-up three missed classes per session if classes are available.

There will be no prorated tuition rates.

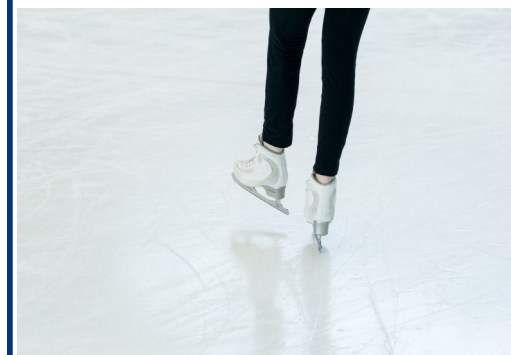
Practice Times
